Directions to Pine Point Arena

From HWY 401 Eastbound—Exit onto Islington Ave Northbound. Take the first street on the right, (Allenby Avenue). Continue on Allenby to Grierson (second right turn). Turn right on Grierson, which takes you into the arena parking lot.

From HWY 401 Westbound—Take Hwy. 401 Westbound toward London. Exit at Islington Avenue North. Turn right onto Chilcot, then right again on Burrard to get to Allenby Avenue. Make a left onto Allenby to Pine Point Arena (less than a ten minute drive from the Hwy. 401 exit).

From the QEW or Gardiner Expressway—Exit onto Hwy 427 Northbound, and exit onto Hwy 401 Eastbound. Exit onto Islington Ave Northbound. Turn right on Allenby Ave (first street on the right). Continue on Allenby to Grierson (second right turn). Turn right on Grierson, which takes you into the arena parking lot.

Saturday, May 29th and Sunday, May 30th 2010—Trials 103, 104, 105, 106

Class Awards

In each class in each Trial, a trophy and rosette will be awarded to the 1st place dog and a rosette will be awarded to the 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed dogs.

Special Awards

A trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring dog for each day as follows:

High Scoring Veteran Dog (7 yrs old or older) ----- Trials 103/104 and Trials 105/106
High Scoring Dog with CKC Agility Title ----- Trials 103/104 and Trials 105/106
High Scoring Dog with CKC Tracking Title ----- Trials 103/104 and Trials 105/106
High Scoring Dog with CKC Rally Title ----- Trials 103/104 and Trials 105/106
High Scoring Swansea Member ----- Trials 103/104 and Trials 105/106

High In Trial:

A special rosette and trophy for highest scoring dog in each trial will be awarded. High in Trial dogs (trials 103, 104, 105 and 106) will also receive a complimentary 8x10 photograph with our Trial photographer.

Low Combined:

Lowest Combined Open B and Utility Award for each Trial. Reminder that both classes must be a qualifying score. This trophy is provided by SDOC to encourage exhibitors to enjoy the spirit of obedience and working with their dogs, no matter what the results.

Please note:

- All trophies and awards must be picked up by the end of the last trial on Sunday May 30th. None will be mailed. Trophies or awards not picked up become the property of the Club.
- Special awards will be presented at the end of the trials on each day. All winners or their designated agent must be present to receive these awards.

Rules

1. The Swansea Dog Obedience Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of, an accident or misfortune however caused to either dogs, exhibitors or property. Dogs must be kept under control at all times.
2. **A judge officiating at an Obedience Trial held under these Regulations shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the Obedience Trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Trial to see that this Regulation is effectively carried out. The Obedience Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of these Regulations, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this Regulation has been violated.**
3. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch is in season after the closing date of the trials. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of judging for the day.
4. The listing fee for a dog not registered with the CKC is \$8.50 per trial (includes GST). A dog must be listed unless it has an individual registration number of an Event Registration Number (ERN) issued by the CKC. Only dogs eligible for registration with the CKC are eligible to compete at these Trials. Failure to obtain an ERN within 30 days of the event will result in any scores being cancelled by the CKC. Please note that dogs are not allowed to compete above the Novice level without a CKC registration number or an ERN. Applications for an ERN can be obtained from the CKC.
5. One dog only may be entered in the Novice "A" and Open Class "A" by any one exhibitor, who must handle the dog in all exercises. Every dog in these classes must be handled by its owner or a member of the immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its utility degree in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in these classes.
6. A dog which has earned its CD in the USA, Bermuda or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in Novice "A", and a dog which has earned its CDX degree in Canada, USA, Bermuda or a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in Open Class "A". Such dogs must be entered in the respective "B" Classes.
7. If any exhibitor enters more than one dog in the Novice B or Open B classes, he/she must have an additional handler for each additional dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.
8. Only those dogs entered in the Trials will be allowed within the precincts of the trial. This area includes the obedience floor, the arena stands and surrounding concrete areas outside the arena boards and glass enclosure.
9. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
10. The Obedience Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the Trials. Emergency Cell # contact Trial weekend (289) 242 – 5827.

Please Note: Pine Point Arena does not allow alcoholic beverages on the premises in accordance with the provincial regulations. Swansea asks your cooperation by complying.

Judging will start at 9:00 am on both days. The trial site will open at 8:00 am.

Ties for Trophies and/or Awards will be resolved by the Judge who completes his/her judging assignment at the latest time in each day.

Entry Information

All trials are limited entry. Entries will close at 8:00 pm **FRIDAY, MAY 14, 2010** or when the judge's assignment has reached 7 hours of judging, based on the formula of 8 Novice, 7 Open and 6 Utility dogs per hour, whichever comes first.

Entry Fee: \$26.00 per entry. Each exhibitor will receive a complimentary copy of the catalogue for our Trials. A listing fee of \$8.50 (including GST) per dog per trial is payable where the CKC registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. The entry fee includes the assessment made to the Trial Holding Club by the CKC. Cheques will be deposited on the closing date.

Attention US Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry (e.g., \$26.00 in US dollars) and no exchange will be refunded. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. We thank you for your co-operation.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action, and cancellation of awards (Chapter 1, Section 8m).
